#### **Report Overview**

This report has been produced to give an overview of the ongoing cleansing and graffiti activities carried out by the City Centre BID.

As well as showing the core activities undertaken, this report also highlights specific areas and zones where particular attention has been paid, also identifying any specific levy payer requests.

#### **Executive Summary**

This section summarises the key areas and tasks covered during the past month. Further detail on each work activity and location is included within this report.

The team continued working hard with their rounds around the city centre, ensuring pavement areas, high contact locations and levy payer premises were kept clean, inviting and sanitised.

The amount of litter and waste being produced, particularly overnight, was very high this month and the team is working through the early hours to ensure the areas are restored to looking pristine for the following days.

The Cleansing team did an excellent job in a thorough deep clean of the pedestrian areas around the Bristol Hippodrome and local hospitality businesses, ready to welcome panto and theatre visitors.

There was again a notable large number of unwanted graffiti and tagging with 214 items of graffiti from over 110 different locations.


The team are working very hard to carry out removal of unwanted graffiti promptly and efficiently, ensuring that levy payers building facades and windows next to street furniture and other general locations are restored back to a clear state.

We continue to proactively identify and remove items of graffiti as well as responding promptly to levy payer requests for removal of items on their premises.

The cleansing team continue to utilise their skills and training in the removal of graffiti, using chemicals and specialist equipment to remove stubborn graffiti and use products to help reduce the risk of repeat tagging in certain areas. We are actively encouraging businesses to report any graffiti or tagging to the police to identify repeat or substantial issues of graffiti in key locations.

## Summary of monthly Activity

We have seen an increase in overnight activity which has led to high amounts of litter and doorway mess and increased demand on pavement washing.

## Summary of monthly activity

We continue to see a large amount of tagging and the team is working very hard to carry out removal promptly and efficiently, ensuring that levy payers building facades and windows next to street furniture and other general locations are restored back to a clear state.

We continue to proactively identify and remove items of graffiti as well as responding promptly to levy payer requests for removal of items on their premises.

We are actively encouraging businesses to report any graffiti or tagging to the police to identify repeat or substantial issues of graffiti in key locations.

\*note that an occurrence constitutes a job or single incident of graffiti. Each occurrence may contain various graffiti items to be removed i.e. 1 occurrence and 4 items / tags of graffiti may need removing.
