The route is all accessible and there are no steps, however there are areas of cobbles on King Street and Corn Street. There is an upward incline as the route goes up High Street and a downward incline towards the bottom of Corn Street. Corn Street will be the narrowest part of the route.

A good place to watch Little Amal from would be Cascade Steps/ waterfront harbourside along to Pero's Bridge. Changing Places are available at Cabot Circus toilets.
