THE PROGRAMME

Bristol's flagship event, the Bristol Harbour Festival returns to the city on the 14th to 16th July. Celebrating communities of Bristol, in the unique setting of its Harbour. There has been a slight change to the footprint of the event this year. Key changes are listed below.

The amphitheatre's *Harbour View* will host a range of talent from Access Creative College, supported by Ujima and BCFM on Saturday evening. The *Circus Playground* will take place in College Green, Jelli Records have moved to Millennium Square providing chill-out beach-bar vibes at the *Jelli Shack* and Harbour Festival programming legend Tony Benjamin will showcase Bristol's Musical talent in our *Music Quarter* in Queens Square.

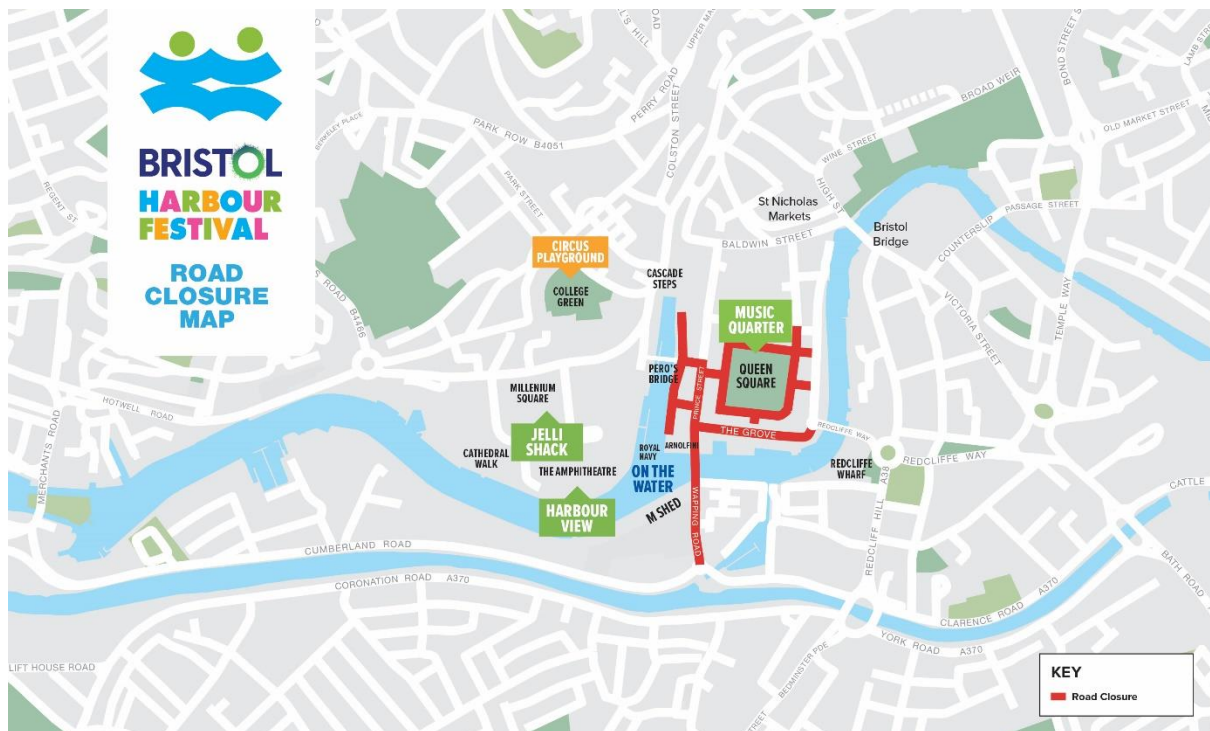

ROAD CLOSURES AND PARKING SUSPENIONS

A number of road closures and suspensions of parking are in place during the Harbour Festival weekend. We have limited these as much as is possible, however these closures are in place for the safety of the public attending the event.

- Queen Square, Queens Charlotte Street, Mill Avenue, Middle Avenue - 00:00 Friday 14th July to 23:00 Sunday 16th July
- The Grove – 19:00 Friday 14th July to 21:00 Sunday 16th July
- Narrow Quay – 19:00 Friday 14th July to 21:00 Sunday 16th July
- Prince Street – 19:00 Friday 14th July to 21:00 Sunday 16th July
- Wapping Road – 06:00 Saturday 15th July to 20:00 Sunday 16th July

ACCESS INFORMATION FOR MERCHANT'S QUAY & WAPPING WHARF

Access to the Merchant's Quay area will be available to residents and businesses via roundabout junction with Wapping Road, Cumberland Road and Commercial Road (next to the Louisiana pub). An access pass is required to obtain access through this road closure. These have been posted to residents and businesses in this area but can also be obtained using a QR code link.

In addition, a roaming security team will be deployed around Marchant's Quay to prevent non-residents accessing the area.

ACCESS INFORMATION FOR QUEEN SQUARE, PRINCE STREET & THE GROVE

Access to Queen Square, Prince Street (between the Prince Street Bridge and NCP Car Park) and The Grove is strictly limited to deliveries for business/residents up until 10am on Friday 14th, Saturday 15th and Sunday 16th. After this time, access will be closed apart from emergency vehicle access. We will keep access to residents/businesses open through the Redcliffe roundabout and to Welsh Back using an access pass. These have been posted to residents and businesses in this area but can also be obtained using the QR code link.
