Quarter 2 Performance Report: April, May, June 2023

- VL ran through the performance report key updates:
  - o New electric cleansing vehicle on road.
  - The BID won the ATCM Partnership award for Safety project work in partnership with Bristol City Council, Avon and Somerset Police, the Universities and others.
  - Love Bristol Gift Card £50,000+ purchased since the card was launched (June 22).
  - o Continuing our contract with PSP until Christmas (£80k+ savings to date).
  - No queries over budget, all as previously discussed.

  - o ASB week of action, work from BID, Police and Council poster distributed to board.

- Park Street shopping square sponsored for Bristol Monopoly Board (VL)
- Old City Planters BID have agreed to take on management and maintenance of planters and setting up seating spaces.
- Support and business liaison is ongoing regards challenges with pedestrianisation in the Old City.

- Work continues to support greening and infrastructure projects: Park Street & Queen's Road/ Old City and King Street.
- Public Art commissioning process underway for King Street BID are part funding and supporting the project. Outcome to be shared at next board meeting.

## **Updates around the table**
