




# Transport Challenges







# Strategic Corridors Programme Update

#### A37/A4018 – No2 route Stockwood to Cribbs Causeway

Central section – Victoria Street – Construction due to commence in Nov 24, complete Feb 26

Southern sections – Wells Road and Stockwood – Final business Oct 24 sign off, construct summer 25

Northern section – currently a review of proposals ahead of business case submission in 2024

#### A38 south – Malago Way & Hengrove/Hartcliffe

Bedminster Green works ongoing, to complete in Summer 2024 Metrobus extension – options being agreed with metrobus operator and Combined Authority including cycle links


